

It's time again for our relaxed weekend in Hoodsport Washington at the Rest-A-While RV Resort on the Hood Canal. This area is wonderful to visit. On a nice day, you can enjoy the beaches, lakes, and National Park in the area. Port Townsend and Port Angeles are also a nice drive. There is a lot of fun GeoCaching in the area and the small town of Hoodsport has fun shops to see. We always seem to relax and have a fun time at this one. This park does not require us to prepay for our sites. We will need the \$10.00 rally fee, but you will pay for your site when you check into the park. They are normally available for extra days, just let me know when you want to come in and leave. The maximum rate is \$38.00 plus tax. They accept credit cards, but offer a discount for Cash or Check. If we have enough coaches registered, we will receive a discount. I will let you know what to expect before you arrive. There are motel rooms available not far from this park if some of our non-camping members are interested. All sites are Full Hook Up with 30-amp service. ## No injuries in Cape George RV fire

A 40-foot motor home was destroyed by fire in the 5000 block of Cape George Road late Tuesday afternoon. The vehicle was unoccupied and there were no injuries.

East Jefferson Fire Rescue was called to a reported recreational vehicle fire at 5:23 p.m., Feb. 26. EJFR Fire Chief Gordon Pomeroy was first on the scene and reported an RV fully engulfed in flames and small explosions emanating from the fire.

EJFR information officer Bill Beezley said that after firefighters arrived the fire was quickly brought under control, but the \$15,000 motorhome was destroyed.

A woman told authorities that she had been in the vehicle approximately one hour earlier and had lit a fire in a wood-burning stove while waiting for a propane contractor to arrive. She identified herself as the mother-in-law of the RV owner.

When the propane contractor arrived, he filled the propane tank halfway and left. The woman then closed the door to the wood-burning stove and left the RV, without extinguishing the fire in the wood-burning stove.

Beezley said in a phone interview that it's important to extinguish any flame in a vehicle or home before leaving.

A passerby noticed smoke and flames coming from the motorhome about 45 minutes later and called 911.

EJFR fire investigators are focusing their investigation on both the wood-burning stove and a Romex electrical wire that ran from the RV up over power lines across Cape George Road and attached to a house on the other side of the road.

Beezley said the RV owner lives on Marrowstone Island and he was unsure who owned the property the RV was parked on. He said its battery was removed and it was up on jacks, rendering it immobile.

"I think it is probably going to end up undeterminable, but accidental," Beezley said of the cause. "It's really difficult to determine in a fire like that where everything was burned so badly."



# RV REFRIGERATOR FIRE

NICEVILLE, FLORIDA - A camper trailer in front of a home on Perdido Circle caught fire Friday morning, according to Niceville Fire Department. No one was injured. The camper was a total loss. The call came at about 7:30 a.m., Niceville Fire reported. The RV was about 20 feet from the home. A refrigerator unit short circuited, causing the 15- to 20-foot flames. East Niceville Fire District, Eglin Air Force Base, and North Bay Fire Control District were on scene as well.

### Dub Box USA expands retro VW camping trailer production

Lovers of the classic VW Transporter camper van will be delighted to hear that the chic retro styled VW camping trailers pioneered by the Herefordshire, UK-based [Dub Box Ltd.](#), have crossed the pond and are now in production at Oregon City-based Dub Box USA. Headed by Heather Bauccio and Shane Medbery, Dub Box USA announced yesterday that they are ramping up production to meet unprecedented demand for their delightful homage to Volkswagen’s classic motor caravan.

“We have gotten so much interest,” said Bauccio during an exclusive [RVing Examiner](#) interview. “We are shocked at how it’s taken off, both on the camper side and on the event trailer side.” Indeed, according to Heather it’s the event trailer side that’s proved the most successful side of the business to-date. Dub Box USA – who have the rights to manufacture and sell the Dub Box in North America and Canada – has already delivered a custom blue and white two-tone event trailer – the Capo VW Dub Box - to Volkswagen’s San Juan Capistrano, California-based dealership which the business is using as a novel marketing tool to help boost their profile in the local community. In addition, “we have a couple of (hotdog) food carts that are going to Hawaii that we’re assembling now,” said Heather. . . .



We prepared to depart and while airing up the suspension, we got the dreaded stop engine light. Thinking it was something as simple as low coolant, Barbara and I added coolant to the reservoir to no avail. Time to call Kevin Waite to see if he was in the desert, which he wasn't. After explaining the problem, he suggested I call his brother who is located in Florida. After a short conversation with Kevin's brother, we decided that the problem was most likely a bad oil pressure switch. Time to call Coach Net to see if they could recommend a mobile tech. After a short wait on hold, the agent proceeded to verify the info they had on file for us and ask about the problem and then I was transferred to their tech help line. They had no information about a local mobile tech and decided we needed to be towed to a repair facility, which I was not too excited about. The tech said he would call back in a few minutes with some updated info. Shortly, he called back and suggested we be towed to Colton Truck Terminal in Colton, CA. That was fine with me because we

have had our coach serviced there in the past and I am pleased with their work. Only problem was Colton couldn't get to us for a few days so there we sat in the campground. On the appointed day, Coach Net called and told us to expect the tow in 30 minutes. The monster wrecker from Yucaipa Towing arrived in 45 and the driver proceeded to put the coach "on the hook." The front end was lifted and secured, an air line was connected to the suspension and brakes, and then the drive line disconnected. The tow lasted for 60 miles and we arrived at Colton right at lunch time so Barbara and I went to lunch and managed to pick up a few geocaches along the way. Back at Colton Truck, the tech said we had a bad oil pressure switch and that it had been delivered, but the wiring harness didn't come with it so we were waiting on another part. Finally, the tech pronounced the problem solved and we were headed back to the desert.

Overall, I can say the experience was "not too bad." The service from Coach Net and Yucaipa Towing was outstanding. It was embarrassing to have the "World's Finest Motorcoach" being towed by a wrecker, but the situation could have been worse.

# “Rally” In Mexico

By the definition in our club’s new member information/jargon list, the planned gathering of several Country Coaches for several days and nights constitutes a Rally. So, we can call the month-long stay of three Northwest Country Coachers in Puerto Penasco, Mexico, a Rally.

Like last year, Don and Barb Schleuse, Bill and Barb Homes and Kris and Lee Casebeer, along with several “some other brand” coaches, met in Gila Bend, Arizona, and caravanned 62 miles south of the US/Mexico border to Puerto Penasco. Also known as Rocky Point by the local Gringos who frequent this quiet little fishing community of over 40,000 residents, it is right on the Gulf of California. Puerto Penasco’s main enterprise is tourism, followed by fishing/shrimping. Shrimping is overtaking commercial fishing as the fisheries in the Sea of Cortez are rapidly depleting. Summer sports fishing, when the water is warmer, is popular. During the winter months, the water is too cold for the type of fish the sports fishermen seek.

My friends and family ask what do we do for a month parked in a Mexican gravel lot less than a 100 yards from the Sea of Cortez. Well, we eat lots of shrimp and other Mexican foods at quaint establishments, some with dirt floors and wait staff that speaks very little English. Venturing to remote beaches for sea-shell collection happens at least twice during our stay. Full moon and extreme low tides yield good clamming. And last, but not least, just relaxing and enjoying the warm sunny climate.


Traveling in this part of Mexico is fairly uneventful, except for the Mexican Army check point just north of town where they are checking for drugs. Some folks feel nervous when a 17-year-old kid dressed in fatigues enters their rig with an assault rifle slung over his shoulder. Once he is satisfied that you have no illegal drugs, you are on your merry way. One important travel note is that there are NO services between the Mexican border town of Sonoyta and Rocky Point. And, there are special insurance considerations for travel in Mexico that are not required in the states.

The locals are friendly. They know what keeps their economy alive. It is not necessary to have Mexican pesos, but the merchant’s exchange rates vary, so exchanging US dollars for pesos is advisable. The banks must see your passport for the money exchange. The reason, I’m told, is to minimize the laundering of illegal drug money.

There are many restaurants that cater mainly to tourists. We try to frequent the less-touristy establishments. The local “color” is more fun and less challenging if you understand the language.

Last year, the three NWCCer Amigo Coaches stayed two weeks; this year, it was a month. The 2014 plan is to stay another month. Adios, hasta luego. Lee Casebeer
